(Austin, TX) - Texans for Lawsuit Reform PAC today endorsed State Rep. Paul Workman in House District 47. In making the endorsement, TLR PAC Chairman Richard J. Trabulsi, Jr., said:

“Rep. Workman is a principled conservative and a strong supporter of the lawsuit reforms that have strengthened the Texas economy, helped create thousands of jobs and assured that Texans have access to doctors and health care. Workman graduated from Texas A&M University in 1973 with a degree in Building Construction and in 1991, founded his own commercial construction company. During his first session in the legislature, Representative Workman co-authored HB 274, designed to significantly reduce frivolous lawsuits and by doing so, help cases to be resolved more quickly and inexpensively. This legislation increases Texas' already significant tort reform laws in effect.

Rep. Workman is the current Republican representative for House District 47. House District 47 includes Bee Cave, Briarcliff, Lakeway, Oak Hill, Onion Creek, San Leanna, Shady Hollow, Sunset Valley, The Hills, and part of Austin.
