REP. PAUL WORKMAN RECEIVES TAXPAYER CHAMPION AWARD

Award is group's highest honor

Austin, TX- State Representative Paul Workman (R-Austin) is honored to receive the designation of "Taxpayer Champion" by Texans for Fiscal Responsibility. Andrew Kerr, executive director of the taxpayer protection group, presented Representative Workman with the award during a constituent event held on September 22, 2011 at The Oasis in Austin.

"We must ensure that Texas remains a pro-business, pro-family and pro-economic growth state," said Workman.
